

AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING THE OPERATION OF OFF-ROAD VEHICLES ON PUBLIC STREETS IN THE CITY OF BYRAM, MISSISSIPPI

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND BOARD OF ALDERMEN OF THE CITY OF BYRAM, MISSISSIPPI, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION ONE

It shall be unlawful for any person(s) to operate, or allow another person to operate, an off-road vehicle as defined by Section 63-31-3 of the Mississippi Code of 1972 upon any public road, street, or highway in the City of Byram, Mississippi, except as follows:

1. By a city employee on official duty and operating the off-road vehicle in commission of the employee's official job duties;
2. By employees of public utilities, as defined by Section 77-3-201 of the Mississippi Code of 1972, operating the off-road vehicle in the commission of the employee's official job duties;
3. By any individual, during the course of a special event authorized by the City of Byram in the performance of official duties specifically related to the approved event on roadways with limited and/or restricted vehicular traffic for the duration of the event;
4. By any individual in the immediate aftermath of a natural or man-made disaster or weather related emergency where the off-road vehicle is used for search, rescue, and recovery of persons and property affected by the emergency; or
5. By any individual at the immediate request and assistance of official public safety personnel during the course of any incident where such off-road vehicles are necessary for search, rescue, and recovery of persons and property in imminent danger.

SECTION TWO

Violation of this ordinance shall be a misdemeanor and shall be punished by a fine of not more than \$1,000 or 90 days in jail or both.

SECTION THREE

This ordinance shall be effective following publication in a newspaper of general circulation in Byram and 30 days from and after passage.

MOTION made to adopt the foregoing Ordinance was made by Alderman MOSEK and SECONDED by Alderman SMITH and the foregoing having first been reduced to writing, was submitted to a Roll Call Vote, the result was as follows:
